Parents, please note that the items and quantities listed below are MANDATORY. The weather at Camp can be unpredictable which means we need clothing for every possible condition.

A few tips: *packing each day's clothes in a zip lock bag is a great way to keep your child organized and clothes clean/ dry. * Jeans get very heavy when they get wet, so we recommend lightweight slacks or pants instead. * Crocks and sport sandals ARE NOT allowed on climbing equipment, so do please send running shoes! Please do pack plastic bags for taking wet clothes home!!! Finally, A book, magazine and or cards are great for early mornings!

Please note that Camp Taiwan provides: sleeping bags, sheets, pillows, pillowcases, towels, soap and shampoo.

The following list of items are NOT allowed at camp and will be confiscated if found.

Camp is a place to enjoy the sights and sounds of nature. There will be enough activities without needing electronic stimulation.

__aerosol cans __firecrackers/lighters/matches or anything flammable __pocket-knives, scissors or any other potentially harmful object

The safety and wellbeing of all our campers comes first.

__food (or drinks)__candy __ Chewing gum

We will arrange for alternative meals for children with religious or medical food needs. There are enough meals and snacks for campers without needing "extras". Also, having food in tents attracts unwanted attention from animals.

__spray paint __markers__glue __cigarettes __alcohol

Children caught vandalizing camp property will be sent home immediately and the replacement cost of the vandalized property will be charged to the child's parent or guardian.
